INSTRUCTIONSTOTHETENDERERS/BIDDERSFORE-SUBMISSIONOFBIDS ONLINETHROUGHE-PROCUREMENTSITE https://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app

This tender document has been published on the Central Public Procurement (CPP) Portal(URL: https://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app). The tenderers/bidders are required to submit softcopies of their bids electronically on the CPP Portal, using valid Digital Signature Certificates(DSC). The instructions given below are meant to assist the tenderers/bidders in registering onthe CPP Portal, prepare their bids in accordance with the requirements and submitting their bids on line on the CPP Portal. More information useful for submitting online bids on the CPPPortal may be obtained at: https://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app

REGISTRATION

- 1) Tenderers/bidders are required to enroll on the e-Procurement module of the Central PublicProcurement Portal (URL: https://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app) by clicking on the link"Clickhereto Enroll"on the CPP Portal. Enrolment is freeofCharge.
 - 2) As part of the enrolment process, the tenderers/bidders will be required to choose auniqueusernameand assign apassword fortheir accounts.
 - 3) Tenderers/bidders are advised to register their valid email address and mobile numbers part of the registration process. These would be used for any communication from the CPPPortal.
 - 4) Upon enrolment, the tenderers/bidders will be required to register their valid DigitalSignatureCertificate(ClassIIorClassIIICertificateswithsigningkeyusage)issuedby any Certifying Authority recognized by CCA India (e.g. Sify / TCS / nCode /eMudhraetc.), with theirprofile.
 - 5) Only one valid DSC should be registered by a tenderer/bidders. Please note that thetenderers/bidders are responsible to ensure that they do not lend their DSC's to otherswhich maylead to misuse.
 - 6) Bidder then logs in to the site through the secured log-in by entering their user ID &passwordand the password of the DSC / e-Token.

SEARCHINGFORTENDERDOCUMENTS

- 1) There are various search options built in the CPP Portal, to facilitate tenderers/bidders tosearch active tenders by several parameters. These parameters could include organizationname, location, date, value, etc. There is also an option of 'Advanced Search' for
 - tenders, wherein the tenderers/bidders may combine a number of search parameters such a sorganization name, form of contract, location, date, other keywords etc. to search for a tender published on the CPP Portal.
- 2) Oncethetenderers/biddershaveselectedthetenderstheyareinterestedin,theymaydownload the required documents / tender schedules. These tenders can be moved to therespective "MyTenders" folder. This would enable the CPPP or talto intimate the tenderers/bidd ers through SMS / e-mail incase there is any corrigendum issued to the tender document.
- 3) The bidder should make a note of the unique Tender ID assigned to each tender, in case theywantto obtain any clarification / help from the Helpdesk.

PREPARATIONOFBIDS

- 1) Tenderer/bidder should take into account any corrigendum published on the tenderdocument before submitting their bids. Please go through the tender advertisement andthe tender document carefully to understand the documents required to be submitted aspart of the bid. Please note the number of covers in which the bid documents have to besubmitted, the number of documents including the names and contents of each of thedocumentsthat need to besubmitted.
- 2) Bidder, in advance, should get ready the bid documents to be submitted as indicated in the tender document / schedule and generally they can be in PDF / XLS / RAR / DWFformats as mentioned. Bid documents may be scanned with 100 dpi with black andwhiteoption.
- 3) To avoid the time and efforts required in uploading the same set of standard documentswhich are required to be submitted as a part of every bid, a provision of uploading suchstandard documents (e.g. PAN card copy, annual reports, auditor certificates etc.) hasbeen provided to the tenderers/bidders. Tenderers/bidders can use "My Space" areaavailabletothemtouploadsuchdocuments. Thesedocumentsmaybedirectlysubmitted from the "My Space" area while submitting the bid just by tagging and neednot be uploaded again and again. This will lead to a reduction in the time required forbidsubmission process.

SUBMISSIONOFBIDS

- 1) Tenderer/bidder should log into the site well in advance for bid submission so thathe/she uploads the Bid in time i.e. on or before the bid submission time as per thesystem.Bidderwill beresponsible for any delay due to other issues.
- 2) Tenderer/bidder has to digitally sign and upload the required bid documents one by oneasindicated in the tenderdocument.
- 3) Tenderer/bidder has to select the payment option as "offline" to pay the Tender Fee &EMDand enter details ofDD/anyother accepted instrument.
- 4) Tenderer/bidder should prepare the EMD instrument as per the instructions specified inthetenderdocument. Scanned copy of DD/any other acceptable instrument as mentioned towards EMD should be uploaded while online submission of the tender and the original should be posted/couriered/giveninperson to the Tender Processing Section latest by the last date and time of bid submission or as specified in the tender documents. The details of the DD/any other accepted instrument, physically sent, should tally with the details available in the Scanned copy and the data entered during bids ubmission time otherwise the Tender will be summarily rejected.
- 5) The TenderInviting Authority (TIA) will not be held responsible for any sort of delayor the difficulties faced during the submission of bids online by the tenderers/bidders. The bidder should see that the bid documents submitted should be free from virus and if the documents could not be opened, due to virus, during tender opening, the bid is liabletobe rejected
- 6) Tenderers/biddersarerequestedtonotethattheyshouldnecessarilysubmittheirfinancial bids in the format provided and no other format shall be acceptable. The pricebid has been given as a standard **Rate Quote Sheet (Item Rate BoQ Template)** (.xlsformat) with the tender document, which is to be downloaded and to be filled by all thetenderers/bidders. Tenderers/bidders are required to download the **Rate Quote Sheet(Percentage BoQ Template)** file, open it and complete the colored (unprotected) cellswiththeirrespectivefinancialquotesandotherdetails(suchasnameoftheTenderer/bidde r).Noothercellsshouldbechanged.Oncethedetailshavebeen

completed, the tenderer/bidder should save it and submit it online, without changing thefilename. If the Rate Quote Sheet (Item Rate BoQ Template) file is found to bemodified by the tenderer/bidder, the bid will be rejected. In e-Tendering, intendingtenderer/bidder can quote their rate in figures only. Therefore, the rate quoted by thetenderer/bidder in figures shall be taken as correct. The Comparative Statement shallalso be generated automatically by the system. The Comparative Statement and ratequoted by each tenderer/bidder shall be downloaded. The manual calculation andchecking of tenders/bids and Comparative Statement, shall be final. In case, anydiscrepancyisnoticed, the decision of appropriate SCIENCE CITY authority shall be final and binding.

- 7) Theservertime(whichisdisplayedonthetender's/bidder'sdashboard)willbeconsidered as the standard time for referring the deadlines for submission of the bids bythe tenderers/bidders, opening of bids etc. The tenderers/bidders should follow this timeduring bid submission. The tenderers/bidders are requested to submit the tenders/bidsthrough online e-tendering system to the **Tender Inviting Authority (TIA)** well beforethebid submission end date &time (as perServerSystem Clock).
- 8) All the documents being submitted by the tenderers/bidders would be encrypted using PKI encryption techniques to ensure the secrecy of the data. The data entered cannot beviewed by unauthorized persons until the time of bid opening. The confidentiality of the bids is maintained using the secured Socket Layer 128 bit encryption technology. Datastorageencryption of sensitive fields is done.
- 9) The uploaded tender documents become readable only after the tender opening by theauthorizedtender/bid openers.
- 10) Uponthesuccessfulandtimely submission oftenders/bids,theportalwillgiveasuccessful tender/bid submission message & a tender/bid summary will be displayed with the NIT/tender/bid no. or Name of Work and the date & time of submission of the tender/bid with all other relevant details.
- 11) Thetender/bidsummaryhastobeprintedandkeptasanacknowledgementofthesubmissionoft hebid. This acknowledgement may be used as an entry pass foranytender/bid openingmeetings.

Science City, Kolkata, a constituent unit under the National Council of Science Museums, (hereinafter referred to as the Museum/Centre) invites e-Tender in twocovers (**TechnicalBidandFinancialBid**) from reputed and experienced agencies as stated in Technical Particulars for the following work:

p). This is the only mode of collection of Tender documents. The same website shall be used for disseminating the dates & time related to pre-bid meeting, tender submission, EMD deposit, tender opening, and opening of financial bid of this tender.

1. Abbreviated Scopeof Work:

- i) Operation and daily checking of equipment, routine maintenance of the entire darkridesystemfrom9 AM to 8.00 PM everydayfor364 days (except Holi).
- ii) Comprehensive, periodical and break down maintenance of the Dark Ride (PeopleMover) system consisting of 10 automated cars having an electrical traction withmotor, gear box, PLC circuit, carbon brushes, various sensors, guide rollers, tyredwheels,
 - castorwheels,mp3audio,wifirouters,speakers,andothercomponents,associated hardware & software to run the system,guided track, synchronizing themovement of the cars with the light & sound show, and all other equipment requiredfor running the dark ride uninterruptedly in the ground floorof Science ExplorationHall,ScienceCity,Kolkata.
- iii) Agency may have to operate the system beyond the hours mentioned as above ifrequired.
- iv) WhiledoingthemaintenanceoftheDarkRide,agencyhastokeepthenecessaryspareparts foruninterrupted runningof theSystem. Regular maintenance and frequent checking of the system shall be ensured by the agency.

2. EligibilityCriteria of theApplicant:

A) Should be registered either as a Company under Companies Act 1956/2013 or Cooperative Society under the Co.op. Society Act, 1972 or Society under the Society Act,

- 1960 or as a Partnership (including Limited Liability Partnership) under Partnership Act, 1932 or Proprietorship Firm or Joint Venture/Consortium, as the case may be, and should be in existence as such entity for not less than five years as on 31.01.2024.
- **B)** Should be in possession of (a) Trade License, if applicable (b) PAN Card [in the name of Company/Firm or Proprietor]: (c) GST Registration issued by the competent authority.
- C) The Registered Office or one of the Branch Offices of the tenderer should be located in and around Kolkata. In case the Tenderer/Bidder do not have such facilities, they should sign a declaration on their letter head to the effect that "In case I/we get the contract after being technically lowest tenderer, I/we will open an office or hire a space to run our office within 20 km within one month of such award of contract, having regular telephone/mobile and other means of communication like fax/e-mail etc., where Science City is located. Failure to do so on our part, our EMD and Security Deposit/Retention Money will be forfeited and the contract will be terminated forthwith" as per the Declaration-3 given in Annexure-A.
- D) The proprietor or any of its partners/directors of the partnership firm/company or the Secretary of the Co.op. Society / Society etc. should not have been black listed/ debarred by any of the government agencies or department or should not have been found guilty of commission of acts of moral turpitude or convicted for any economic offence or for violation of any labour laws etc. by any court or any authority appointed to enforce any labour laws or regulations including PF/ESI authorities. Further, no past contract of such Tenderer/Bidder should have been terminated in the past 3 years on account of violation of laws or deficiency of services or breach of contract. In case of concealment of any facts in this regard, Science City reserves the right to cancel/terminate the contract without giving any notice. Tenderer/Bidder is required to submit the certificate to this effect as per Annexure-C.
- E) Minimum 05 (Five) years' experience in executing similar kind of contracts/services for 'Operation and Comprehensive Maintenance of thedark ride (People Mover) of EvolutionPark consisting of 10 electrically operated automated cars thattravel on guided tracks,PLC based software and associated software, synchronizing the movement of the vehicleswith the light & sound show and other associated equipment" in Central Government/ State Govt./Autonomous Bodies/Public Sector Undertakings/Local Bodies / Municipalities / large Corporate Bodies. Tenderer shall attach (a) list of such organizations with contact nos. where the Tenderer/Bidder is currently providing/ has earlier provided similar kind of services, (b) copies of work orders and (c) completion certificates/ performance certificate from such organisations in support of their claim must be attached as per Annexure-D.
- F) Minimum Average Annual turnover of the firm (Lead Partner in case of JV/Consortium) should be Rs. 24.0 Lakhs during the 3 (three) financial years out of last 5 financial years. [Tenderer shall attach relevant documents (audited report Trading, P/L & BS from authorized Chartered Accountant) with the Technical bid as proof]. Also attach the Brief summary of Average Annual Turnover duly certified by authorized CA in the format attached in Annexure-E.
- G) The Tenderer (Lead partner in case of JV/Consortium) should have undertaken and successfully executed similar works i.e. 'Operation and Comprehensive Maintenance of thedark ride (People Mover) of EvolutionPark consisting of 10 electrically operated automated cars thattravel on guided tracks, PLC based software and associated software,

synchronizing the movement of the vehicleswith the light & sound show and other associated equipment' during last five financial years in any Central Government/ State Government/ Autonomous Bodies/Public Sector Undertakings/ Local Bodies/ Municipalities / large Corporate Bodies and meet any one of the following criteria:

3. EvaluationCriterion

(A) TechnicalEvaluation:

Selection process of the bidders for opening the financial bids:

- 1. The documents submitted by Bidders shall be evaluated for their experience in theoperation and maintenance of of installations having electromechanical systems, programming of PLC software, running the round the clock services where the visitors are involved, operation of the meparks and as desired by Science City.
- 2. The Bidders shall be shortlisted on the basis of details submitted along with thesupporting documents in Annexure A, B (Details of the bidder), C, D, E, F and experience criteria.

(B) Financial Evaluation:

- 1. The bidders must submit rates for Five years of Daily Operation and Routine Maintenance Charges and Comprehensive Maintenance Chargesseparately and combined rate shall be considered for financial evaluation. Bidders should quote the charges in whole rupee (in INR) in Rate Quote Sheet (Online item BOQ) in .xls format.
- 2. The year-wie Price- Break up for five years of Operation and routine maintenance charges and comprehensive charges should be filled in pdf format as per format in Annexure-G and enclosed in the Financial Bid

4. EarnestMoneyDeposit (EMD):

The tenderer/s shall be required to deposit a sum of Rs. **60,000.00** (Rupees Forty thousandonly) as Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) along with the Tenders in cover 1 (**EMD Cover**). The earnest money shall be deposited by Crossed Demand Draft or Banker's Cheque orpay order in favour of "**Science City, Kolkata**" of any Nationalized or Scheduled bank which should reach the office of Science City at least one day before the last date of Bid Submission.

Scanned copies of valid and updated certificates issued by NSIC under Single Point Registration Scheme (SPRS) and MSME Registration certificate in .PDF format should be uploaded for considering the waiver of EMD submission. In addition, the bidders registered under Department of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSME) and/or eligible for exemption from submitting Bid Security / Earnest Money Deposit for similar services shall be required to submit Bid Security declaration as per Annexure-III of the e-NIT.

The EMDoftheunsuccessfulTenderer(s)shallberefundedwithoutinterestonwrittenrequest after the date of acceptance of the Final Work Order by the successful tenderer oncompletion of the tender process or within sixty days from the date of opening of thetenders.

The

EMDofthesuccessfulBidder, who is formally awarded the Work Order, shall be for feited if the tenderer refuses to implement whole or part of the work after receiving the Work Order.

5. SecurityDeposit(SD):

A security deposit of minimum 5% of the annual value of contract, subject to a maximum of Rs. 20.00 lakh is to be deposited by the Successful Bidder either in the form of electronic transfer mode i.e. NEFT/RTGS (bank details are furnished in Information & Instructions to Bidders) or through demand draft/pay order drawn in favour of 'Science City, Kolkata', payable at Kolkata to cover the risk or any loss caused to the Science City due to fraud, theft, pilferage etc., the responsibilities for which are attributable, directly or otherwise, due to the negligence or inefficiency on the part of the agency or personnel deployed by them for the purpose of the contract, or any breach of contract of whatsoever nature or on the part of the agency. In the event of any such occurrence and/or breach of contract, the amount of compensation, as assessed by the Science City shall be final and binding on the bidder/tenderer and the same shall be recovered either from the bill for Annual Operation and Maintenance Contract charges due to the Agency or from their security deposit at the discretion of the competent authority of Science City.

The Security Deposit will be refunded to the successful contractor (without any interest) within **two** months of the expiry of the contract only on the satisfactory performance of the contract and on fulfilment of all statutory obligations and payments.

[Note: No exemption will be allowed for submission of Security Deposit/Retention Money to NSIC/MSME certified firms. However, concession for submission of EMD shall be applicable to the Tenderers/Bidders registered with NSIC/MSME as per prevailing Govt. guidelines. The Tenderers/Bidders should upload document of the firm for claiming such exemption. Tenderer/Bidder must upload signed Annexure—F, if the bidder is registered under NSIC/MSME.]

6. Tenureof the Work:

The successful bidder shall be awarded work on year to year basis upon satisfactoryperformanceoftheagency. Initially, the successful biddershall be awarded the work of or 03 months on trial basis, thereafter extended for 09 months' subject to satisfactory performance of the agency/ successful Tenderer/Bidder. The contract may be renewed on year-to-year basis based on the satisfactory performance for a maximum period of Five (05) years (including trial period) at the discretion of Competent Authority of Science City as per the quoted rate in the BoQ with the existing terms and conditions of the initial contract. However, competent authority of Science City, Kolkata may incorporate or discard any clauses at his/her sole discretion according to the need and suitability of Science City, Kolkata.

- 9. The intending tenderers/bidders must read the terms and conditions of NCSM/ScienceCity carefully. They should only submit their bid if they consider themselves eligible andiftheyarein possessionofall the documents required. Date of Opening of Financial bids will be communicated later through CPPP or any other means, as applicable.
- 10. Information and Instructions for tenderers/bidders posted on website shall form a part of the biddocument.
- 11. The biddocument consisting of the contractions of the set of Terms and Conditions of the contract to be executed, the set of Terms and Conditions of the contract to be complied with, scope of work for operation, scope of work for comprehensive annual maintenance, annexures and other necessary documents can be seen and

- 12. Out of the online bid documents submitted by intending tenderers/bidders, the technicalbids of only of those tenderers/bidders shall be opened, who havedeposited e-Tenderwith Earnest Money Deposit as specified duly scanned, uploaded and found in order. Andthe financial bids of only those tenderers/bidders shall be opened when technical bids are inconformity with the eligibility criteria, experience, specifications & uploaded necessarydocuments.
- 13. Those contractors not registered on the website mentioned above, are required to getthemselvesregistered beforehand.
- **14.** The intending tenderer/bidder must have valid Class II or Class III Certificates withsigningkeyusage(DSC)to submit thebid.
- **15.** The agency should assess the volume of work and submit a **detailed work plan** as a partofthe (TechnicalBid) PART-1 of thetender document.
- 16. The e-Tenders are invited under two envelopes system. The first electronic envelopenamedas Technical Bid Envelope (Cover 1) shall contain the EMD, details often derer's /bidder's satisfying the eligibility conditions, NIT, etc. and the second electronic envelope named as Financial Bid Envelope (Cover 2) containing Rate Quote Sheet.
